An original, four color lithograph, printed by Ed Hamilton at Hamilton Press in Venice, California. The edition was pulled on Gray Rives.

Execution: The artist drew directly on a stone and three aluminum plates. The first plate was drawn with a toner wash, applied with a brush, over a gum arabic stop out, which had been applied with a brush. Lithographic crayons were used for drawing on the stone and the other two plates. The colors were printed as follows:

1. Gray
2. White
3. Yellow
4. Black

Size: 36x21" bleed image, torn and deckle edges

 - CTP5 On Gray Rives, printed in gray and black
 - CTP6 On White Rives, printed in gray and black
 - CTP7 On White Rives, printed in tan, white and black
 - CTP8 On Gray Rives, printed in white and black
 - CTP9 On White Rives, printed in gray, white and black
 - CTP10 On Gray Rives, printed in gray, white, yellow, with additional crayon black added by hand
- 20 Edition

All other proofs and impressions were destroyed and the stone and printing plates were effaced. This print bears the chop of the printer, and was published by Hamilton Press.
